AN ACT ESTABLISHING A CONNECTICUT CLEAN DIESEL PROGRAM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 That the general statutes be amended to create a Connecticut Clean
- 2 Diesel Program to implement policies to significantly reduce the health
- 3 risks from diesel pollution and help the state meet federal air quality
- 4 standards for fine particulate matter, which policies will focus in part
- 5 on diesel emission reductions from state-funded fleets, school buses
- 6 and home heating oil.

Statement of Purpose:

To reduce the health risks from diesel pollution and to help the state meet federal air quality standards for fine particulate matter.
