**AN ACT CONCERNING OUTSOURCING.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

- 1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) Every contract to which  
2 the state or any political subdivision of the state is a party shall contain  
3 the following provision: The contractor agrees and warrants that in the  
4 performance of the contract such contractor will not use any  
5 subcontractor, person or group of persons from a site that is located  
6 outside the United States or transfer any of the contracted work or  
7 service to a location outside the United States, unless the contracted  
8 work or service is not available in the United States.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:

**Statement of Purpose:**

To prohibit contractors and subcontractors under contracts awarded by state agencies and quasi-public agencies from employing persons in foreign countries to perform the contracted work or services.
