AN ACT CONCERNING SPECIAL POLICEMEN IN THE SPECIAL INVESTIGATION SECTION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE SERVICES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subdivision (9) of section 53a-3 of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*
3 *passage*):

4 (9) "Peace officer" means a member of the Division of State Police
5 within the Department of Public Safety or an organized local police
6 department, a chief inspector or inspector in the Division of Criminal
7 Justice, a state marshal while exercising authority granted under any
8 provision of the general statutes, a judicial marshal in the performance
9 of the duties of a judicial marshal, a conservation officer or special
10 conservation officer, as defined in section 26-5, a constable who
11 performs criminal law enforcement duties, a special policeman
12 appointed under section 29-18, 29-18a, 29-18b or 29-19, an adult
13 probation officer, an official of the Department of Correction
14 authorized by the Commissioner of Correction to make arrests in a
15 correctional institution or facility, any investigator in the investigations

16 unit of the office of the State Treasurer or any special agent of the
17 federal government authorized to enforce the provisions of Title 21 of
18 the United States Code.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:		
Section 1	<i>from passage</i>	53a-3(9)

Statement of Purpose:

To include tax enforcement agents in the special investigation section of the Department of Revenue Services in the definition of "peace officer" for purposes of Title 53a of the general statutes.
