AN ACT CONCERNING CERTAIN OBSOLETE PROVISIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE SERVICES STATUTES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Section 4a-5a of the general statutes is repealed and the
2 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

3 Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes, each state
4 agency, except (1) the agencies within the Legislative Department, (2)
5 the Judicial Department, and (3) the constituent units of the state
6 system of higher education, shall use the services of the [state regional
7 laundry system, the facilities of the Central State Warehouse, the State
8 Data Center and the Office of Administrative Support,] Department of
9 Administrative Services if the Department of Administrative Services
10 can: (A) Provide the particular goods or services requested by such
11 state agency, (B) comply with the delivery schedule set forth by such
12 state agency, and (C) provide such goods or services at a cost which is
13 not more than three per cent greater than the price quoted to such state
14 agency by any private vendor.

15 Sec. 2. Section 4a-51 of the general statutes is repealed and the
16 following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from passage*):

17 (a) The Commissioner of Administrative Services shall: (1)
18 Purchase, lease or contract for all supplies, materials, equipment and
19 contractual services required by any state agency, except as provided
20 in sections 4-98 and 4a-57; (2) enforce standard specifications
21 established in accordance with section 4a-56; [(3) establish store rooms
22 and warehouses for the storage of the state's property in such locations
23 as may best serve the requirements of the state agencies; (4) operate
24 such trucks and garages as are necessary to deliver supplies, materials
25 and equipment from such central store rooms and warehouses to any
26 state agency; (5)] (3) establish and operate a central duplicating and
27 mailing room for state agencies located in or near the city of Hartford
28 and such other places as he deems practical; [, provided the State
29 Library photostat and offset printing department and the duplicating
30 facilities of the Department of Public Health shall remain as
31 constituted; and (6)] and (4) establish and operate or have supervisory
32 control over [central or regional bakeries, meat cutting establishments,
33 laundries and] other central supply services in such locations as may
34 best serve the requirements of the state agencies.

35 (b) The Commissioner of Administrative Services, when purchasing
36 or contracting for the purchase of dairy products, poultry, eggs, fruits
37 or vegetables pursuant to subsection (a) of this section, shall give
38 preference to dairy products, poultry, eggs, fruits or vegetables grown
39 or produced in this state, when such products, poultry, eggs, fruits or
40 vegetables are comparable in cost to other dairy products, poultry,
41 eggs, fruits or vegetables being considered for purchase by the
42 commissioner that have not been grown or produced in this state.

43 Sec. 3. Section 5-200d of the general statutes is repealed. (*Effective*
44 *from passage*)
