AN ACT CONCERNING THE ADMINISTRATIVE LOCATION OF THE OFFICE OF THE VICTIM ADVOCATE AND THE OFFICE OF THE CHILD ADVOCATE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. Subsection (b) of section 46a-13b of the general statutes is
2 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*

7 Sec. 2. Subsection (b) of section 46a-13k of the general statutes is
