**AN ACT ESTABLISHING A PILOT PROGRAM TO PROVIDE
HOMECARE SERVICES TO PERSONS WITH HUMAN
IMMUNODEFICIENCY VIRUS OR ACQUIRED IMMUNE DEFICIENCY
SYNDROME.**

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Assembly convened:

1 Section 1. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The Commissioner of Social
2 Services shall apply for a home and community-based services waiver
3 pursuant to Section 1915(c) of the Social Security Act that will allow
4 the commissioner to develop and implement a program for the
5 provision of home and community-based services, as defined in 42
6 CFR 440.180, to not more than one hundred persons who (1) have
7 tested positive for human immunodeficiency virus or have acquired
8 immune deficiency syndrome, and (2) would be eligible for Medicaid
9 if admitted to a hospital, nursing facility or intermediate care facility
10 for the mentally retarded, or in the absence of the services that are
11 requested under such waiver, would require the Medicaid covered
12 level of care provided in such facilities. In accordance with 42 CFR
13 440.180, such persons shall be eligible to receive services that are
14 deemed necessary by the commissioner to meet their unique needs in
15 order to avoid institutionalization.

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
