**RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE RULES OF THE SENATE FOR THE  
DECEMBER RECONVENED SESSION OF THE OCTOBER 25, 2005  
SPECIAL SESSION OF THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY.**

Resolved by the Senate:

1 That the rules of the Senate at this reconvened session of the 2005  
2 General Assembly shall be the same as the rules of the Senate in force at  
3 the 2005 regular session, except as such rules are amended, altered or  
4 repealed in this resolution and by the addition of the following rules,  
5 which additional rules are hereby made part of said Senate rules.

6 Strike out Rule 8 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

7 Rule 8. The clerk shall keep a journal of the Senate and shall enter  
8 therein a record of each day's proceedings.

9 Strike out Rule 9 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

10 Rule 9. The clerk shall keep a calendar on which he shall enter daily  
11 all Senate bills disapproved by the Governor and all bills and joint  
12 resolutions received from the House for action.

13 Strike out Rule 19 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

14 Rule 19. The order of business shall be as follows:

15 1. Reception of communications from the Governor and Secretary of  
16 the State.

17 2. Introduction of resolutions.

18 3. Introduction of bills disapproved by the Governor.

19 4. Reception of business from the House.

20 5. Business on the calendar.

21 6. Introduction of guests.

22 Strike out Rule 20 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

23 Rule 20. Before any resolution is received, a brief statement of its  
24 object shall be made by the introducer.

25 Strike out Rule 23.

26 Strike out Rule 29 and insert in lieu thereof the following:

27 Rule 29. When a question is under debate, no motion shall be received  
28 except:

29 1. To adjourn.

30 2. To recess.

31 3. For the previous question.

32 4. To close the debate at a specified time.

33 5. To pass temporarily.

34 6. To pass retain.

35 7. To postpone to a certain time.

36 Said motions shall have precedence in the order listed in this rule.

37 Strike out Rule 30.

38 Add a new Rule 37 as follows:

39 Rule 37. No substantive resolutions shall be received except for  
40 resolutions concerning joint rule 33, and resolutions pertaining to the  
41 rules of this reconvened session, the printing of the journals of the Senate  
42 and the House of Representatives, and the expenses of this reconvened  
43 session.
