**"AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RETAIL SALE OF BEER BY
PERSONS WHO HOLD A MANUFACTURER PERMIT FOR BEER
OR A BREW PUB."**

1 In line 29, before "The" insert the following "Such selling at retail
2 from the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers shall
3 comply with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as
4 amended by this act, and shall permit not more than eight liters of beer
5 to be sold to any person on any day on which such sale is authorized
6 under the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by
7 this act."

8 In line 85, after "beer" insert "brewed on such premises"

9 In line 93, after the closing bracket insert "Such selling at retail from
10 the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers shall comply
11 with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by
12 this act, and shall permit not more than eight liters of beer to be sold to
13 any person on any day on which such sale is authorized under the

14 provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by this act."

15 After line 95, insert the following:

16 "Sec. 2. Subsections (d) and (e) of section 30-91 of the general
17 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
18 (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

19 (d) The sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating
20 under package store permits, drug store permits, manufacturer
21 permits for a brew pub, manufacturer permits for beer or grocery store
22 beer permits shall be unlawful on Decoration Day, Independence Day,
23 Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, New Year's Day, Sunday or Christmas
24 or, if Independence Day, Christmas or New Year's Day occurs on a
25 Sunday, on the Monday next following such day except that such sale
26 or dispensing shall be lawful on any Independence Day occurring on a
27 Saturday; and such sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places
28 operating under package store permits, drug store permits,
29 manufacturer permits for a brew pub, manufacturer permits for beer
30 and grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on any other day
31 before eight o'clock a.m. and after nine o'clock p.m. [It shall be
32 unlawful for the holder of a manufacturing permit for a brew pub to
33 sell beer for consumption off the premises on the days or hours
34 prohibited by this subsection.] Any town may, by a vote of a town
35 meeting or by ordinance, reduce the number of hours during which
36 such sale shall be permissible.

37 (e) (1) In the case of any premises operating under a tavern permit,
38 premises operating under a manufacturer permit for a brew pub, a
39 manufacturer permit for beer or premises operating under a cafe
40 permit, wherein, under the provisions of this section, the sale of
41 alcoholic liquor is forbidden on certain days or hours of the day, or
42 during the period when a tavern permit, manufacturer permit for a
43 brew pub, manufacturer permit for beer or cafe permit is suspended, it
44 shall likewise be unlawful to keep such premises open to, or permit it
45 to be occupied by, the public on such days or hours.

46 (2) For a period of one year after October 1, 1999, the provisions of
47 this subsection shall not apply to any premises operating under a
48 manufacturer permit for a brew pub in which class III gaming, as
49 defined in the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, P.L. 100-497, 25 USC
50 2701, et seq., may be legally conducted."
