1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) The sum of five hundred thousand
4 dollars is appropriated to the Department of Public Safety, from the
5 General Fund, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, for the purpose
6 of providing funds to the state-wide firearms trafficking task force
7 established pursuant to section 29-38e of the general statutes. Such
8 funds shall not lapse on June 30, 2005, and shall continue to be

9 available for expenditure for such purpose during the fiscal year
10 ending June 30, 2006."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
