**"AN ACT TO CORRECT A TECHNICAL ERROR IN ECS  
DISTRIBUTION AND TO SPECIFY DISPOSITION OF THE  
FAIRFIELD HILLS HOSPITAL PROCEEDS."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 10-264l of the general statutes is  
4      repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*  
5      *passage*):

6      (c) (1) The maximum amount each interdistrict magnet school  
7      program shall be eligible to receive per enrolled student shall be  
8      determined as follows: (A) For each participating district whose  
9      magnet school program enrollment is equal to or less than thirty per  
10     cent of the magnet school program total enrollment, ninety per cent of  
11     the foundation as defined in subdivision (9) of section 10-262f; (B) for  
12     each participating district whose magnet school program enrollment is  
13     greater than thirty per cent but less than or equal to sixty per cent of  
14     the magnet school program total enrollment, a percentage between

15 sixty and ninety per cent of said foundation that is inversely  
16 proportional to the percentage of magnet school program students  
17 from such district; and (C) for each participating district whose magnet  
18 school program enrollment is greater than sixty per cent but less than  
19 or equal to ninety per cent of the magnet school program total  
20 enrollment, a percentage between zero and sixty per cent of said  
21 foundation that is inversely proportional to the percentage of magnet  
22 school program students from such district. The amounts so  
23 determined shall be proportionately adjusted, if necessary, within the  
24 limit of the available appropriation, and in no case shall any grant  
25 pursuant to this section exceed the reasonable operating budget of the  
26 magnet school program, less revenues from other sources. Any magnet  
27 school program operating less than full-time but at least half-time shall  
28 be eligible to receive a grant equal to sixty-five per cent of the grant  
29 amount determined pursuant to this subsection.

30 (2) For [fiscal years ending June 30, 2003, and June 30, 2004] the  
31 fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, the commissioner may, within  
32 available appropriations, provide supplemental grants for the  
33 purposes of enhancing educational programs in such interdistrict  
34 magnet schools as the commissioner determines. Such grants shall be  
35 made after the commissioner has reviewed and approved the total  
36 operating budget for such schools, including all revenue and  
37 expenditure estimates."
