1      Strike section 7 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
2      thereof:

3      "Sec. 7. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) (a) Any law enforcement  
4      officer who issues a summons for a violation of section 1, 2 or 6 of this  
5      act shall record, on any summons form issued in connection with the  
6      matter, the specific nature of any distracted driving behavior observed  
7      by such officer that contributed to the issuance of such summons.

8      (b) If a summons for a violation of section 1, 2 or 6 of this act is  
9      issued by a law enforcement officer of a municipality, fifteen dollars of  
10     any such fine imposed shall be forwarded to such municipality."
