**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF HAND-HELD MOBILE
TELEPHONES AND HAND-HELD MOBILE ELECTRONIC DEVICES
BY OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES."**

1 Strike subsection (b) of section 1 and sections 2 to 8, inclusive, in
2 their entirety and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(b) The Commissioner of Transportation shall require, in
4 accordance with section 14-108a of the general statutes, that, on or
5 before January 1, 2006, the uniform investigation of accident report
6 contain a determination by the police officer, agency or individual who
7 investigates an accident as to whether the use of any hands-free mobile
8 telephone, mobile electronic device or mobile telephone was a
9 contributing factor to such accident. The commissioner shall, not later
10 than February 1, 2007, submit a report, in accordance with the
11 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
12 committees of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters

13 relating to transportation and public safety on the number of motor
14 vehicle accidents in which the use of any hands-free mobile telephone,
15 mobile electronic device or mobile telephone was a contributing
16 factor."
