"AN ACT CONCERNING WORKPLACE SAFETY."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) Notwithstanding any
4 provision of any special act, charter or ordinance, on or after October 1,
5 2005, no municipality may enter into any project labor agreement
6 unless such municipality holds a public hearing on such proposed
7 agreement. At such public hearing and in the notice thereof, the
8 municipality shall set forth the general provisions of the proposed
9 project labor agreement. The municipality shall give notice of the time
10 and place of such hearing by publication in a newspaper having a
11 substantial circulation in such municipality, such notice to be given at
12 least twice, at intervals of not less than two days, the first not more
13 than fifteen days nor less than ten days and the second not less than
14 two days before such hearing. For purposes of this section,
15 "municipality" means any town, city or borough, or other political
16 subdivision of the state."
