**"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS
AND SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION."**

1 Strike section 27 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 27. Section 10-266p of the general statutes is amended by
4 adding subsection (f) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2005*):

5 (NEW) (f) In addition to the amounts allocated in subsection (a), and
6 subsections (c) to (e), inclusive, of this section, for the fiscal year
7 ending June 30, 2006, the State Board of Education shall allocate one
8 million thirty-nine thousand six hundred eighty six dollars to the
9 towns that rank one to three, inclusive, in population pursuant to
10 subdivision (1) of said subsection (a), and for the fiscal year ending
11 June 30, 2007, the State Board of Education shall allocate one million
12 six hundred ten thousand seven hundred ninety-eight dollars to the
13 towns that rank one to three, inclusive, in population pursuant to

14 subdivision (1) of said subsection (a)."

15 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
16 internal references accordingly:

17 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) For the fiscal years ending June 30,
18 2006, and June 30, 2007, the Commissioner of Education shall provide
19 grants in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars each to each
20 town (1) with a population of less than fifteen thousand, and (2) that
21 ranks in the bottom third when all towns are ranked in descending
22 order according to town wealth as defined in section 10-262f of the
23 general statutes."
