**"AN ACT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES FOR THE PROGRAMS
AND SERVICES OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) A state-wide organization or
4 association that sponsors or organizes interscholastic sports, in
5 conjunction with the Department of Public Health and the Department
6 of Education, shall develop and adopt guidelines for anabolic steroid
7 testing.

8 Sec. 502. Subsection (d) of section 49 of substitute house bill 6940 of
9 the current session is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
10 thereof (*Effective July 1, 2005*):

11 (d) Funds appropriated to the Office of Policy and Management in
12 subsection (a) of this section, for Contingency Needs, shall not lapse on

13 June 30, 2005, and shall continue to be available for expenditure for
14 such purpose as follows: The sum of \$10,000,000 shall be available
15 during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006; the sum of \$8,000,000 shall
16 be available during the fiscal year ending June 30, 2007. The Secretary
17 of the Office of Policy and Management is authorized to expend such
18 amounts for special projects, except that the sum of \$500,000 for the
19 fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, and the sum of \$500,000 for the fiscal
20 year ending June 30, 2007, shall be used to fund testing conducted in
21 accordance with section 501 of this act."
