"AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION."

1 Strike section 36 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "Sec. 36. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) Any commissioner, deputy
4 commissioner, state agency or quasi-public agency head or deputy,
5 person in charge of state agency procurement and contracting who has
6 reasonable cause to believe that a person has violated the provisions of
7 the Code of Ethics for Public Officials set forth in part I of chapter 10 of
8 the general statutes or any law or regulation concerning ethics in state
9 contracting shall report such belief to the State Ethics Commission,
10 which may further report such information to the Auditor of Public
11 Accounts, Chief State's Attorney or the Attorney General."

12 Strike subsection (m) of section 41 and insert the following in lieu
13 thereof:

14 "(m) No public official or state employee shall knowingly accept,
15 directly or indirectly, any gift, as defined in subsection (e) of section 1-
16 79, as amended by this act, from any person the official or employee
17 knows or has reason to know: (1) Is doing business with or seeking to
18 do business with the department or agency in which the official or
19 employee is employed; (2) is engaged in activities which are directly
20 regulated by such department or agency; or (3) is prequalified under
21 section 4a-100. No person shall knowingly give, directly or indirectly,
22 any gift or gifts in violation of this provision. For the purposes of this
23 subsection, the exclusion to the term "gift" in subdivision (12) of
24 subsection (e) of section 1-79 for a gift for the celebration of a major life
25 event shall not apply. Any person prohibited from making a gift under
26 this subsection shall report to the State Ethics Commission any
27 solicitation of a gift from such person by a state employee or public
28 official."

29 Strike section 51 in its entirety and renumber the remaining sections
30 accordingly
