"AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subdivision (3) of subsection (b) of section 46a-68 of the
4 general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu
5 thereof (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

6 (3) The Commission on Human Rights and Opportunities and the
7 Permanent Commission on the Status of Women shall provide [a
8 minimum of ten hours of training per year] training concerning state
9 and federal discrimination laws and techniques for conducting internal
10 investigations of discrimination complaints to persons designated by
11 state agencies, departments, boards or commissions as affirmative
12 action officers and persons designated by the Attorney General or the
13 Attorney General's designee to represent such agencies, boards,
14 departments or commissions pursuant to subdivision (5) of this
15 subsection. Such training shall be provided for a minimum of ten

16 hours during the first year of service or designation, and a minimum of
17 five hours per year thereafter."
