**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE IMPLEMENTATION AND FUNDING  
OF A LOBSTER RESTORATION PROGRAM."**

1 In line 12, strike "within available appropriations" and insert "if  
2 funds become available" in lieu thereof

3 In line 14, strike "shall" and insert "may" in lieu thereof

4 In line 20, strike ", within available appropriations,"

5 Strike section 2 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu  
6 thereof:

7 "Sec. 2. (NEW) (*Effective July 1, 2005*) The Commissioner of  
8 Environmental Protection shall do all things necessary to apply for,  
9 qualify for and accept any federal or state funds made available or  
10 allotted under any federal or state act for the restoration of lobster  
11 stock, or any other federal or state acts, projects, programs or activities  
12 related thereto. The commissioner shall administer any such funds

13 allotted to the commissioner in accordance with federal law and the  
14 law of this state. The commissioner may enter into contracts with the  
15 federal government or any state government concerning the use,  
16 maintenance, and repayment of such funds under any such federal or  
17 state act."
