THE COMMISSIONER OF SOCIAL SERVICES TO THE GENERAL
ASSEMBLY."**

1 In line 26, before "For", insert the following: "If the commissioner, in
2 good faith, believes that disclosure of the name and address of an
3 employer pursuant to subdivision (1) of this subsection may indirectly
4 result in the disclosure of the identity of any person who receives state-
5 funded medical assistance benefits, the commissioner shall not include
6 the name and address of such employer in the annual report, but the
7 commissioner shall, in all other respects, comply with the provisions of
8 this subsection. The commissioner shall also include in the annual
9 report the number of employers whose names and addresses were not
10 disclosed based on the commissioner's good faith belief that such
11 disclosure could indirectly result in the disclosure of the identity of
12 persons receiving state-funded medical assistance benefits."
