"AN ACT REVISING STATUTES RELATIVE TO FIREARMS."

1 Strike lines 9 to 19, inclusive, and substitute the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(2) The Department of Public Safety, Department of Mental Health
4 and Addiction Services and Judicial Department shall, in accordance
5 with state and federal law regarding confidentiality, enter into a
6 memorandum of understanding with the Federal Bureau of
7 Investigation for the purpose of implementing the National Instant
8 Criminal Background Check System in the state. The Department of
9 Public Safety shall report the name, date of birth and physical
10 description of any person prohibited from possessing a firearm
11 pursuant to 18 USC 922(g) or (n) to the National Instant Criminal
12 Background Check System Index, Denied Persons Files."
