**"AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RETAIL SALE OF BEER BY
PERSONS WHO HOLD A MANUFACTURER PERMIT FOR BEER
OR A BREW PUB."**

1 In line 29, before "The" insert the following "Such selling at retail
2 from the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers shall
3 comply with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as
4 amended by this act, and shall permit not more than eight liters of beer
5 to be sold to any person on any day on which such sale is authorized
6 under the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by
7 this act."

8 In line 93, after the closing bracket insert "Such selling at retail from
9 the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers shall comply
10 with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by
11 this act, and shall permit not more than eight liters of beer to be sold to
12 any person on any day on which such sale is authorized under the
13 provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by this act."

14 After line 95, insert the following:

15 "Sec. 2. Subsections (d) and (e) of section 30-91 of the general
16 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
17 (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

18 (d) The sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating
19 under package store permits, drug store permits, manufacturer
20 permits for a brew pub, manufacturer permits for beer or grocery store
21 beer permits shall be unlawful on Decoration Day, Independence Day,
22 Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, New Year's Day, Sunday or Christmas
23 or, if Independence Day, Christmas or New Year's Day occurs on a
24 Sunday, on the Monday next following such day except that such sale
25 or dispensing shall be lawful on any Independence Day occurring on a
26 Saturday; and such sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places
27 operating under package store permits, drug store permits, and
28 grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on any other day before
29 eight o'clock a.m. and after nine o'clock p.m. [It shall be unlawful for
30 the holder of a manufacturing permit for a brew pub to sell beer for
31 consumption off the premises on the days or hours prohibited by this
32 subsection.] Any town may, by a vote of a town meeting or by
33 ordinance, reduce the number of hours during which such sale shall be
34 permissible.

35 (e) (1) In the case of any premises operating under a tavern permit,
36 premises operating under a manufacturer permit for a brew pub, a
37 manufacturer permit for beer or premises operating under a cafe
38 permit, wherein, under the provisions of this section, the sale of
39 alcoholic liquor is forbidden on certain days or hours of the day, or
40 during the period when a tavern permit, manufacturer permit for a
41 brew pub, manufacturer permit for beer or cafe permit is suspended, it
42 shall likewise be unlawful to keep such premises open to, or permit it
43 to be occupied by, the public on such days or hours.

44 (2) For a period of one year after October 1, 1999, the provisions of
45 this subsection shall not apply to any premises operating under a

46 manufacturer permit for a brew pub in which class III gaming, as
47 defined in the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, P.L. 100-497, 25 USC
48 2701, et seq., may be legally conducted."
