**"AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE RETAIL SALE OF BEER BY
PERSONS WHO HOLD A MANUFACTURER PERMIT FOR BEER
OR A BREW PUB."**

1 In line 29, before "The" insert the following "Such selling at retail
2 from the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers shall
3 comply with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as
4 amended by this act."

5 In line 93, after the closing bracket insert "Such selling at retail from
6 the premises of sealed bottles or other sealed containers shall comply
7 with the provisions of subsection (d) of section 30-91, as amended by
8 this act."

9 After line 95, insert the following:

10 "Sec. 2. Subsections (d) and (e) of section 30-91 of the general

11 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
12 (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

13 (d) The sale or dispensing of alcoholic liquor for off premises
14 consumption in places operating under package store permits, drug
15 store permits, manufacturer permits for a brew pub, manufacturer
16 permits for beer or grocery store beer permits shall be unlawful on
17 Decoration Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day,
18 New Year's Day, Sunday or Christmas or, if Independence Day,
19 Christmas or New Year's Day occurs on a Sunday, on the Monday next
20 following such day except that such sale or dispensing shall be lawful
21 on any Independence Day occurring on a Saturday; and such sale or
22 dispensing of alcoholic liquor in places operating under package store
23 permits, drug store permits, and grocery store beer permits shall be
24 unlawful on any other day before eight o'clock a.m. and after nine
25 o'clock p.m. [It shall be unlawful for the holder of a manufacturing
26 permit for a brew pub to sell beer for consumption off the premises on
27 the days or hours prohibited by this subsection.] Any town may, by a
28 vote of a town meeting or by ordinance, reduce the number of hours
29 during which such sale shall be permissible.

30 (e) (1) In the case of any premises operating under a tavern permit,
31 premises operating under a manufacturer permit for a brew pub, a
32 manufacturer permit for beer or premises operating under a cafe
33 permit, wherein, under the provisions of this section, the sale of
34 alcoholic liquor is forbidden on certain days or hours of the day, or
35 during the period when a tavern permit, manufacturer permit for a
36 brew pub, manufacturer permit for beer or cafe permit is suspended, it
37 shall likewise be unlawful to keep such premises open to, or permit it
38 to be occupied by, the public on such days or hours.

39 (2) For a period of one year after October 1, 1999, the provisions of
40 this subsection shall not apply to any premises operating under a
41 manufacturer permit for a brew pub in which class III gaming, as
42 defined in the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, P.L. 100-497, 25 USC
43 2701, et seq., may be legally conducted."
