"AN ACT CONCERNING MURDER WITH SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) Notwithstanding any
4 provision of the general statutes, whenever any person stands
5 convicted of a felony involving the use, attempted use or threatened
6 use of physical force against another person and has, at separate times
7 prior to the commission of the present crime, been twice convicted of a
8 felony involving the use, attempted use or threatened use of physical
9 force against another person, the court shall sentence such person to
10 life imprisonment without the possibility of release, as defined in
11 section 53a-35b of the general statutes, as amended by this act."
