"AN ACT CONCERNING CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEMS."

1 After line 81, insert the following and renumber the remaining
2 subdivision accordingly:

3 "(5) No person shall be deemed to have transported a child in
4 violation of subdivision (1) of this subsection for failure to provide and
5 require a child weighing less than sixty pounds to use a child restraint
6 system unless such person has actual knowledge or reasonable cause
7 to believe that the child being transported weighs less than sixty
8 pounds. No person shall be deemed to have transported a child in
9 violation of subdivision (2) of this subsection for failure to provide and
10 require a child weighing less than twenty pounds to ride rear-facing in
11 a child restraint system unless such person has actual knowledge or
12 reasonable cause to believe that the child being transported weighs less
13 than twenty pounds."
