"AN ACT CONCERNING CHILD RESTRAINT SYSTEMS."

1 Strike everything after the enacting clause and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "Section 1. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of Public
4 Health, or the commissioner's designee, shall, within available
5 appropriations, conduct a study of all appropriate national statistics on
6 child restraint systems, including booster seats. The study shall
7 consider usage rates of restraint systems and the effectiveness of such
8 systems in preventing or reducing injuries to children involved in
9 motor vehicle incidents and make recommendations for changes in
10 state law based on the findings of such study.

11 (b) Not later than October 1, 2005, the commissioner shall report, in
12 accordance with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes,
13 the findings and recommendations of the study, and recommendations
14 for policies and procedures to implement the findings and
15 recommendations, to the joint standing committee of the General

16 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to transportation."

This act shall take effect as follows and shall amend the following sections:
