**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE OF HAND-HELD MOBILE
TELEPHONES AND HAND-HELD MOBILE ELECTRONIC DEVICES
BY OPERATORS OF MOTOR VEHICLES."**

1 Strike sections 3 and 4 in their entirety and substitute the following
2 in lieu thereof:

3 "Sec. 3. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) Any person who violates
4 section 1 of this act shall have committed an infraction, except that the
5 fine shall be suspended for a first time violator who provides proof of
6 acquisition of a hands-free accessory subsequent to the violation but
7 prior to the imposition of a fine.

8 Sec. 4. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) Any person who violates
9 section 2 of this act shall have committed an infraction."

10 Strike section 6 in its entirety and substitute the following in lieu
11 thereof:

12 "Sec. 6. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) An operator of a motor

13 vehicle who commits a moving violation, as defined in subsection (a)
14 of section 14-111g of the general statutes, while engaged in any activity
15 prohibited under section 5 of this act shall have committed an
16 infraction, which penalty shall be in addition to any penalty or fine
17 imposed for the moving violation."

18 Strike section 8 in its entirety
