"AN ACT CONCERNING THE USE IN COURT PROCEEDINGS OF CERTAIN COMMUNICATIONS MADE TO MARITAL AND FAMILY THERAPISTS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) During the initial
4 consultation between a marital and family therapist licensed in
5 accordance with section 20-195c of the general statutes and any person
6 who consults the marital and family therapist for purposes of
7 diagnosis or treatment, the marital and family therapist shall inform
8 such person of the communications that may be disclosed without
9 such person's consent pursuant to subsection (c) of section 52-146p of
10 the general statutes, as amended by this act."
