**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO STUDY EMINENT
DOMAIN LAWS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective July 1, 2005*) (a) There is established a Municipal
4 Relief Task Force. The task force shall review all existing unfunded
5 state mandates on municipalities and school districts to determine the
6 necessity of such mandates and whether or not the burden placed on
7 municipalities and school districts by such mandates can be reduced or
8 eliminated. The task force shall also review state mandates on
9 municipalities and school districts that are partially funded.

10 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members: (1) One
11 appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives, who shall
12 be from a municipality with a population of more than seventy-five
13 thousand; (2) one appointed by the minority leader of the House of
14 Representatives, who shall be from a municipality with a population of

15 less than ten thousand; (3) one appointed by the president pro tempore
16 of the Senate, who shall be from a municipality with a population of
17 more than twenty thousand but less than seventy-five thousand; (4)
18 one appointed by the minority leader of the Senate, who shall be from
19 a municipality with a population of less than twenty thousand; (5) four
20 appointed by the Governor, one of whom shall be selected by the
21 Governor to be the chairperson; (6) a representative of the Connecticut
22 Conference of Municipalities, who shall be appointed by said
23 conference; (7) a representative of the Council of Small Towns who
24 shall be appointed by said council; and (8) a representative of the
25 Connecticut Association of Boards of Education who shall be
26 appointed by said association.

27 (c) The task force shall report, in accordance with section 11-4a of
28 the general statutes, its findings to the Governor and the General
29 Assembly no later than January 1, 2006."
