1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding any provision of
4 the general statutes or any regulation adopted pursuant to chapter
5 368d of the general statutes, the scope of practice of any person
6 certified as an emergency medical technician-basic, emergency medical
7 technician-intermediate or emergency medical technician-paramedic
8 under regulations adopted pursuant to section 19a-179 of the general
9 statutes shall include the administration of oral aspirin, use of
10 glucometers, and the placement of CombiTubes or similar devices,
11 provided such activities are performed only at the direction of hospital
12 based control."
