1 In line 9, before the period insert the following: ", including
2 affordable housing, as defined in section 8-39a of the general statutes"

3 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
4 internal references accordingly:

5 "Sec. 501. Subsection (c) of section 8-30g of the general statutes is
6 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective from*

7 *passage*):

8 (c) ~~(1)~~ Any commission, by regulation, may require that an
9 affordable housing application seeking a change of zone shall include
10 the submission of a conceptual site plan describing the proposed
11 development's total number of residential units and their arrangement
12 on the property and the proposed development's roads and traffic
13 circulation, sewage disposal and water supply.

14 (2) Any commission may charge twice the application fee for an
15 affordable housing application concerning an affordable housing
16 development containing over one hundred units, and may charge
17 three times the application fee for an affordable housing application
18 concerning an affordable housing development containing over two
19 hundred dwelling units."
