"AN ACT CONCERNING BOATING SAFETY."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) The Commissioner of
4 Environmental Protection, in consultation with a stakeholder group
5 appointed by the commissioner, shall complete a comprehensive study
6 of the safe boating certificate program and requirements of such
7 program, as established pursuant to sections 15-140e to 15-140g,
8 inclusive, of the general statutes, with regard to possible changes to
9 program content based on vessel type and size and the feasibility of
10 establishing a streamlined safe boating certificate course for persons
11 operating vessels propelled exclusively by electric motors on inland
12 waters of the state upon which motor powered vessels exceeding ten
13 horsepower are prohibited.

14 (b) Not later than January 1, 2006, the commissioner shall complete
15 the study and report the results of such study, in accordance with the
16 provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes, to the joint standing
17 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
18 relating to the environment."
