1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) Each collective
4 bargaining agreement between an employer, as defined in section 5-
5 270 of the general statutes, and an employee organization, as defined
6 in said section 5-270, which is executed on or after October 1, 2005,
7 shall contain a provision imposing upon the employees covered by
8 such agreement a minimum copayment obligation of six dollars per
9 generic drug prescription and a minimum copayment obligation of
10 twelve dollars per brand name drug prescription."
