**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE REGISTRATION OF SEXUAL OFFENDERS."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Subdivision (1) of subsection (a) of section 54-258 of the  
4      general statutes is repealed and the following is substituted in lieu  
5      thereof (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

6      (1) Notwithstanding any other provision of the general statutes,  
7      except subdivisions (3) and (4) of this subsection, the registry  
8      maintained by the Department of Public Safety shall be a public record  
9      and shall be accessible to the public during normal business hours. The  
10     Department of Public Safety shall make registry information available  
11     to the public through the Internet. The Department of Public Safety  
12     shall provide on its Internet web site direct links to registry  
13     information of all other states that make such information available to  
14     the public through the Internet. Not less than once per calendar  
15     quarter, the Department of Public Safety shall issue notices to all print

16 and electronic media in the state regarding the availability and means  
17 of accessing the registry. Each local police department and each state  
18 police troop shall keep a record of all registration information  
19 transmitted to it by the Department of Public Safety, and shall make  
20 such information accessible to the public during normal business  
21 hours."
