**"AN ACT CONCERNING ENFORCEMENT OF SPEEDING AND  
TRAFFIC CONTROL SIGNAL VIOLATIONS."**

1 After line 47, add the following:

2 "(d) An automated traffic enforcement device used by a  
3 municipality pursuant to this section shall be activated and record  
4 images only upon detecting the approach of a motor vehicle and a  
5 probable violation.

6 (e) An automated traffic enforcement device that is designed to  
7 automatically record the image of the license plate of a motor vehicle  
8 that is entering an intersection in violation of a traffic control signal  
9 shall only be used at an intersection where the duration of the yellow  
10 signal light is no less than the duration of the yellow signal light  
11 recommended under regulations adopted by the State Traffic  
12 Commission."

13 In line 48, strike "(d) Any" and insert the following in lieu thereof:

14       "(f) Except as provided in subsection (g) of this section, any"

15       After line 50, add the following:

16       "(g) One-half of any fine collected by a municipality pursuant to this  
17 section with respect to a violation of a traffic control signal that was  
18 placed and maintained by the State Traffic Commission shall be paid  
19 to the State Treasurer for deposit in the Special Transportation Fund.

20       (h) Any municipality that authorizes the use of automated traffic  
21 enforcement devices pursuant to this section shall report the location  
22 where any such device is installed to the State Traffic Commission."
