**"AN ACT REQUIRING THE INSTALLATION OF CARBON
MONOXIDE DETECTORS IN NEW RESIDENTIAL BUILDINGS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
4 2007, the State Building Inspector and the State Fire Marshal, in
5 conjunction with the Codes and Standards Committee, shall make
6 amendments to the State Building Code and the State Fire Safety Code,
7 in accordance with the provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes,
8 to require the installation of a floor proximity path marking system
9 that shall include path markers, path marking materials and related
10 devices to identify the path of emergency egress by providing a visible
11 delineation of the path of travel along the designated exit access that
12 shall be continuous, except as interrupted by doorways, hallways,

13 corridors or other architectural features, in occupancies regulated by
14 the State Fire Safety Code and constructed, substantially renovated or
15 established by change of use under a building permit application filed
16 on or after January 1, 2007. Such path markers and path marking
17 materials shall include markers and materials that are electrical and
18 photoluminescent."
