**"AN ACT CONCERNING BILLBOARDS, VISION SCREENING,  
DRIVER LICENSE AND EMISSIONS FRAUD, AND THE EMISSIONS  
ENTERPRISE FUND."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsection (a) of section 14-270c of the general statutes is  
4 repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective*  
5 *October 1, 2005*):

6 (a) The Commissioners of Public Safety and Motor Vehicles shall  
7 staff the official weighing areas as follows:

8 (1) Greenwich: [Eight work shifts in each seven-day period from  
9 Sunday through Saturday. No such shifts shall be worked  
10 consecutively, except that two shifts may be worked consecutively on  
11 not more than three days;] Sufficient work shifts for the weigh stations  
12 to be open every week day (A) from 6:00 a.m. until 10:00 a.m.,

13 inclusive, (B) from 6:00 p.m. until 10:00 p.m., inclusive, and (C) during  
14 eight additional random hours;

15 (2) Danbury: Three work shifts in each seven-day period from  
16 Sunday through Saturday. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall,  
17 whenever possible, coordinate coverage between this official weighing  
18 area and the official weighing area in Greenwich in order to ensure  
19 concurrent coverage;

20 (3) Union: Between five and eight work shifts in each seven-day  
21 period from Sunday through Saturday. The Commissioner of Motor  
22 Vehicles shall coordinate the hours of operation of this official  
23 weighing area; and

24 (4) Portable scale locations: Ten shifts in each seven-day period from  
25 Sunday through Saturday which shall be staggered throughout the  
26 four geographical areas established by the Commissioner of Public  
27 Safety with concentration in areas that have fewer hours of operation  
28 for the permanent weighing areas."
