"AN ACT CONCERNING TAXING DISTRICTS TO PAY FOR SOUND BARRIERS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Section 14-12 of the general statutes is amended by adding
4 subsection (l) as follows (*Effective July 1, 2005*):

5 (NEW) (l) (1) Each passenger motor vehicle that has a propelling
6 engine with a piston displacement of five and four-tenths liters or
7 more and having a gross vehicle weight rating of more than six
8 thousand five hundred pounds shall pay a surcharge of two hundred
9 fifty dollars for each new registration or renewal of registration for the
10 vehicle.

11 (2) There shall be a sound barrier account, which shall be a
12 nonlapsing account within the Special Transportation Fund. All funds

13 received by the Commissioner of Transportation pursuant to
14 subdivision (1) of this subsection shall be deposited into said account.
15 The commissioner shall authorize the expenditure of the funds in the
16 account for the purposes of installing highway sound barriers as
17 provided in section 7-326, as amended by this act."
