**"AN ACT CONCERNING SOCIAL SECURITY OFFSETS UNDER
THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION ACT."**

1 Strike lines 49 to 55, inclusive, in their entirety and substitute the
2 following in lieu thereof:

3 "(e) Notwithstanding any provision of the general statutes to the
4 contrary, compensation paid to an employee for an employee's total
5 incapacity shall be reduced while the employee is entitled to receive
6 old age insurance benefits pursuant to the federal Social Security Act,
7 except that such compensation shall not be reduced if the employee (1)
8 was previously receiving old age insurance benefits, returned to
9 employment thereafter and suffered an injury that arose out of and in
10 the course of such employment, or (2) was simultaneously employed
11 and receiving old age insurance benefits and suffered an injury that
12 arose out of and in the course of such employment. The amount of
13 each reduced workers' compensation payment shall equal the excess, if
14 any, of the workers' compensation payment over the old age insurance
15 benefits."
