"AN ACT CONCERNING REVISIONS TO CERTAIN CRIMINAL STATUTES, THE DISCLOSURE OF PERSONAL INFORMATION OF EMPLOYEES OF CERTAIN AGENCIES AND THE SALE OF BODY ARMOR."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) The courts shall hold
4 harmless any person or entity, without limitation, from any suits,
5 claims, costs, demands, judgments, liability or other causes of action
6 arising from or related to the use of a firearm or firearm ammunition
7 by another person if the other person directly or indirectly obtained
8 the firearm or firearm ammunition through the commission of (1)
9 burglary, in violation of section 53a-101, 53a-102, 53a-102a, 53a-103 or
10 53a-103a of the general statutes, (2) robbery, in violation of section 53a-

11 134, 53a-135, 53a-136 or 53a-136a of the general statutes, or (3) larceny,
12 in violation of section 53a-122, 53a-123, 53a-124, 53a-125, 53a-125a or
13 53a-125b of the general statutes."
