**"AN ACT CONCERNING THE PENALTY FOR COMMERCIAL  
VEHICLES ON STATE PARKWAYS."**

1      After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
2      internal references accordingly:

3      "Sec. 501. Section 14-237 of the general statutes is repealed and the  
4      following is substituted in lieu thereof (*Effective October 1, 2005*):

5      (a) When any highway has been divided into two roadways by  
6      leaving an intervening space or by a physical barrier or clearly  
7      indicated dividing section, each vehicle shall be driven only upon the  
8      right-hand roadway and no vehicle shall be driven over or across any  
9      such dividing space, barrier or section, except through an opening or  
10     at a crossover or intersection established by public authority. Violation  
11     of any provision of this section shall be an infraction.

12     (b) No operator of a wrecker, as defined in section 14-1, may cross  
13     or drive over a median divider, as defined in said section 14-1, at an  
14     opening, crossover or intersection not for public use, unless such

15 operator of such wrecker is responding to a call from the state police."
