**"AN ACT ESTABLISHING A TASK FORCE TO MONITOR THE
PROPOSED LIQUEFIED NATURAL GAS FACILITY IN LONG
ISLAND SOUND."**

1 Strike subsection (b) of section 1 and insert the following in lieu
2 thereof:

3 "(b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

4 (1) Three appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives,
5 one representing a municipality located on Long Island Sound, and
6 one experienced in the field of natural gas supply and demand and the
7 siting of liquefied natural gas facilities and one a public member;

8 (2) Three appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate, one
9 representing an environmental nonprofit organization, one
10 representing a municipality located on Long Island Sound and one a
11 member of the public;

12 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
13 Representatives representing a nonprofit group whose primary
14 purpose is protection of the Long Island Sound;

15 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate who may be
16 a member of the public;

17 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
18 Representatives representing who shall be a member of the public;

19 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate representing
20 a harbor management commission;

21 (7) The Commissioners of Environmental Protection, Public Health
22 and Agriculture and the chairperson of the Department of Public
23 Utility Control, or their designees; and

24 (8) Two persons appointed by the Governor one of whom shall be a
25 member of the Connecticut Siting Council."
