**"AN ACT CONCERNING VOLUNTEERS PARTICIPATING IN  
 HOMELAND SECURITY DRILLS OR RESPONDING TO FIRE OR  
 AMBULANCE CALLS."**

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and  
 2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) No collective bargaining  
 4 agreement between a municipality and a municipal employee  
 5 organization executed on or after the effective date of this section but  
 6 before September 30, 2007, shall contain a requirement prohibiting a  
 7 paid employee of a municipality from engaging in volunteer services  
 8 as a firefighter, emergency medical technician, paramedic or  
 9 ambulance driver during off-duty hours."
