"AN ACT CONCERNING DAMAGE BY ROAMING LIVESTOCK AND DOGS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective from passage*) Not later than January 1,
4 2006, and annually thereafter, the Commissioner of Agriculture shall
5 (1) collect available data from animal control officers and other sources
6 on the incidents and frequency of dog bites in this state during the
7 prior calendar year, (2) categorize the data based on breed of dog, and
8 (3) submit a report to the joint standing committee of the General
9 Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to insurance. The
10 report shall specify the breed of dogs responsible for such bites, the
11 city or town where the bites occurred and any disciplinary action taken
12 or caused to be taken against the dog or dog owner by an animal
13 control officer."
