"AN ACT CONCERNING CRIMINAL BACKGROUND CHECKS FOR NURSING HOME EMPLOYEES WHO PROVIDE DIRECT CARE TO RESIDENTS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) (a) The Commissioner of
4 Public Safety shall adopt regulations, in accordance with the
5 provisions of chapter 54 of the general statutes, to provide a uniform
6 method of identifying and labeling buildings incorporating truss
7 construction.

8 (b) Municipalities may require that owners of buildings
9 incorporating truss construction post identification on such buildings
10 which conforms to the provisions of the regulations adopted pursuant
11 to this section.

12 Sec. 502. (*Effective from passage*) Notwithstanding the provisions of
13 subdivision (1) of subsection (b) of section 19-13-B33b of the

14 regulations of Connecticut state agencies, as they specifically apply to
15 section 26.2 of the Department of Public Health Swimming Pool
16 Design Guide, the Sacred Heart University Whirlpools at the William
17 H. Pitt Center may deviate from the required decking width, provided
18 local rescue personnel provide documentation to the Commissioner of
19 Public Health which attests that a reduced decking will not impair or
20 hinder the rescue of individuals using such whirlpools."
