"AN ACT CONCERNING CHARTER RENEWAL IN CHARTER SCHOOLS."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. Subsections (b) and (c) of section 10-14n of the general
4 statutes are repealed and the following is substituted in lieu thereof
5 (*Effective from passage*):

6 (b) Beginning in the 2005-2006 school year, the state-wide mastery
7 examinations pursuant to subsection (a) of this section shall be
8 administered in March or April.

9 (c) Notwithstanding the provisions of subsections (a) and (b) of this
10 section, the state-wide mastery examinations pursuant to this section
11 shall be administered as follows:

12 (1) Beginning in the 2005-2006 school year, each student enrolled in
13 grades three to eight, inclusive, and ten in any public school shall,

14 annually, in March or April, take a state-wide mastery examination
15 that measures the essential and grade-appropriate skills in reading,
16 writing and mathematics; and

17 (2) Beginning in the 2007-2008 school year, each student enrolled in
18 grades five, eight and ten in any public school shall, annually, in
19 March or April, take a state-wide mastery examination in science."
