**"AN ACT CONCERNING PENSION AND OTHER BENEFITS FOR
STATE EMPLOYEES SERVING IN THE MILITARY."**

1 Strike subdivision (2) of subsection (c) of section 2 in its entirety and
2 substitute the following in lieu thereof:

3 "(2) In addition to the paid leave of absence provided under
4 subdivision (1) of this subsection, the state employee shall be entitled
5 to any paid leave of absence provided under the Uniformed Services
6 Employment and Reemployment Rights Act, 38 USC Chapter 43, as
7 amended from time to time, and, if such state employee has served
8 overseas for a period of at least two years, a paid leave of absence for
9 the two-week period beginning on the date the employee returns to
10 state employment from the call-up to active service. The Commissioner
11 of Administrative Services shall adopt regulations, in accordance with
12 the provisions of chapter 54, as necessary, to implement the provisions
13 of this subdivision."

14 Strike subdivision (2) of subsection (a) of section 501 in its entirety
15 and substitute the following in lieu thereof:

16 "(2) Each appointing authority shall grant to each full-time
17 employee in a permanent position in the state service who has
18 furnished satisfactory proof of (A) the birth or adoption of a child of
19 the employee, or (B) a serious illness of a child, spouse or parent of the
20 employee, up to ten days of such sick leave with pay as has accrued to
21 the employee's credit pursuant to subdivision (1) of this subsection."
