"AN ACT CONCERNING GOVERNMENT ADMINISTRATION."

1 After the last section, add the following and renumber sections and
2 internal references accordingly:

3 "Sec. 501. (*Effective from passage*) (a) There is established a task force
4 to study the number of state employees. Such study shall include, but
5 not be limited to, an examination of the number of state employees
6 that are required to meet the state's contracting needs.

7 (b) The task force shall consist of the following members:

8 (1) Two appointed by the speaker of the House of Representatives;

9 (2) Two appointed by the president pro tempore of the Senate;

10 (3) One appointed by the majority leader of the House of
11 Representatives;

- 12 (4) One appointed by the majority leader of the Senate;
- 13 (5) One appointed by the minority leader of the House of
14 Representatives;
- 15 (6) One appointed by the minority leader of the Senate;
- 16 (7) The Commissioner of Administrative Services, or the
17 commissioner's designee; and
- 18 (8) Two persons appointed by the Governor.
- 19 (c) Any member of the task force appointed under subdivision (1),
20 (2), (3), (4), (5) or (6) of subsection (b) of this section may be a member
21 of the General Assembly.
- 22 (d) All appointments to the task force shall be made no later than
23 thirty days after the effective date of this section. Any vacancy shall be
24 filled by the appointing authority.
- 25 (e) The speaker of the House of Representatives and the president
26 pro tempore of the Senate shall select the chairpersons of the task
27 force, from among the members of the task force. Such chairpersons
28 shall schedule the first meeting of the task force, which shall be held no
29 later than sixty days after the effective date of this section.
- 30 (f) The administrative staff of the joint standing committee of the
31 General Assembly having cognizance of matters relating to
32 government administration and elections shall serve as administrative
33 staff of the task force.
- 34 (g) Not later than January 1, 2010, the task force shall submit a
35 report on its findings and recommendations to the joint standing
36 committee of the General Assembly having cognizance of matters
37 relating to government administration and elections, in accordance
38 with the provisions of section 11-4a of the general statutes. The task
39 force shall terminate on the date that it submits such report or January
40 1, 2010, whichever is earlier."
