23 "Sec. 501. (Effective July 1, 2005) Notwithstanding any provision of
24 the general statutes, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the
25 Department of Education shall grant to each town the same grant the
26 town received for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2005, pursuant to
27 subdivision (6) of subsection (a) of section 10-262h of the general
28 statutes, as amended, and the unexpended funds appropriated to the
29 department for Education Equalization Grants shall be granted to
30 towns so that each town receives a minimum of three hundred twenty-
31 five dollars per resident student to fund education costs. The amount
32 of grants payable to towns pursuant to this subdivision shall be
33 reduced proportionately if the total of such grants exceeds the amount
34 appropriated for such grants."
