- 3 "Sec. 501. (NEW) (*Effective October 1, 2005*) No employer or an
4 employer's agent, representative or designee shall discharge, discipline
5 or otherwise penalize any employee because (1) the employee, or a
6 person acting on behalf of the employee, makes a good faith report,
7 verbally or in writing, of a suspected violation of the licensing
8 requirements of chapter 393, 394 or 482 of the general statutes; or (2)
9 the employee refuses to engage in, or participate with others in the
10 engagement in, any unlicensed activity which would be prohibited by
11 such chapters."
