**"AN ACT CONCERNING COMPREHENSIVE CAMPAIGN FINANCE REFORM FOR STATE-WIDE CONSTITUTIONAL AND GENERAL ASSEMBLY OFFICES."**

1 Change the effective date of sections 19, 28 to 31, inclusive, and 33 to  
2 "effective from passage"

3 In lines 2507, 2564, 2575, 2599 and 2620 strike "December 31, 2006"  
4 and insert in lieu thereof "the effective date of this section"

5 Strike section 55 in its entirety and insert the following in lieu  
6 thereof:

7 "Sec. 55. (NEW) (Effective from passage) If a court of competent  
8 jurisdiction prohibits or limits the expenditure of funds from the  
9 Citizens' Election Fund established in section 2 of this act for grants or  
10 moneys for candidate committees authorized under sections 1 to 17,  
11 inclusive, of this act for a period of seventy-two hours or more, (1)  
12 sections 1 to 17, inclusive, 47 to 49, inclusive, 52 and 53 of this act shall  
13 be inoperative and have no effect, and (2) (A) the amendments made to

14 the provisions of the sections of the general statutes pursuant to this  
15 act shall be inoperative, (B) the provisions of said sections of the  
16 general statutes, revision of 1958, revised to December 30, 2006, shall  
17 be effective, and (C) the provisions of section 9-333b, subsection (g) of  
18 section 9-333l, section 9-333l, subsections (a) and (b) of section 9-333m,  
19 section 9-333n, subsections (g) to (j), inclusive, of section 9-333n and  
20 section 9-333o shall not be implemented."
